PROMPT PAYMENT REBATE (PPR)
PROMPT PAYMENT DISCOUNT (PPD)

USC Intermodal offers you a choice of discount programs. You may choose either the “**Prompt Payment Rebate**” or the “**Prompt Payment Discount.**” A 21% discount shall apply to all Examination charges listed on our schedule of charges when full payment is received within **20 days** from invoice date.

The rebate/discount applies to examination charges only and does not apply to warehouse handling, storage, facility fees, per diem, or any other charges.

Prompt Payment Rebate (PPR): We will send you a check, by the fifteenth of the month, for all earned rebates of the preceding month. This program will give you a lump-sum check plus a statement detailing examinations earning rebates.

Prompt Payment Discount (PPD): You may deduct directly from your invoice the amount in the “date due and discount” area on our invoice. This program provides an immediate discount when invoice is paid within 20 days.

You choose the form of discount most appropriate for your needs. For assistance, please contact either Jay Russell or Mike Rodriguez at (310)522-1900. Either of them will be glad to help you select the discount program that is best for you. If you are already a Prompt Payment Rebate or Discount user, you need to do nothing unless you want to switch your program.

We are required by the IRS to have customer information on file for tax purposes if you are participating in the Prompt Payment Rebate program. If you elect the Prompt Payment Discount program the customer information form is used only to notify us of your choice. (The customer information form is the second page. Please make selection and return via fax.)

Per Public Bulletin 96-089 issued 12/13/96. Special fee arrangements between a CES operator and its clients are permitted. Section 5.j of the Agreement of Understanding reads as follows: see 5. j. The CES operator will assess service fees strictly in accordance with the fee schedule included in the CES operator’s approved application or as changed under the provisions of 19 CFR 118.5. Fee schedules must include all special fee arrangements and/or discounts that are offered. No deviation from the fee schedule is permissible. The CES operator must provide 90 calendar days advance written notice to the Port Director of any proposed fee schedule changes, which will include written notice to the Port Director of any proposed fee schedule, which will include written justification for any increased or additional fees.
